**ORDER AUTHORIZING DEBTOR'S (I) USE OF EXISTING BUSINESS FORMS
AND RECORDS, (II) MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING CORPORATE BANK
ACCOUNTS, AND (III) MAINTENANCE OF CASH MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of Dia Deb International Inc., the debtor and debtor in-possession herein (the "Debtor"), for entry of an order, pursuant to § 105(a) of Title 11 of the United States Code, as amended (the "Bankruptcy Code"), authorizing the Debtor's (a) continued use of existing business forms and records, (b) maintenance of existing corporate bank accounts, and (c) maintenance of its cash management system; and there being due and sufficient notice of the Motion under the circumstances; and upon the record of the hearing on the Motion; this Court having determined that granting the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate, creditors and equity security holders; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted to the extent provided herein; and it is further

ORDERED, that, as set forth in the Motion, the Debtor is authorized (a) to continue to use its existing business forms and records, (b) to maintain the Continuing Bank Accounts (as defined in the Motion), and (c) to maintain its cash management system, provided that the Debtor stamps or otherwise imprints the term "Debtor-in-Possession" on all checks; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Debtor is authorized and empowered to take such actions as may be necessary and appropriate to implement the terms of this Order.
